

Useful Driving Notes for the Houston, TX Training Facility

- Much of Beltway 8 (Sam Houston Parkway) is a TOLL road
- The Northwest Freeway (HWY 290) runs East/West and is a major artery to downtown Houston, so traffic is often heavy.
- When exiting 290, you will be placed onto a **one-way** access road (also referred to as the Northwest Freeway) that runs alongside the highway. This means that when approaching the office from the South/East (Downtown area), you will exit 290 onto the access road and continue traveling West, even though it will take you past our office (which is located on the Eastbound side of 290.) There are “turnarounds” provided that will allow you to make a legal U-Turn so that you can get to the other side of the Freeway, at which point our office will be on the RIGHT as you head East on the Northwest Freeway access road. If you miss your turn, you can simply make another loop to get back to the correct spot. This setup is common with most of the major interstates in and around the Houston area!
- To avoid making such large circles when traveling to and from your hotel, you may ask the front desk for alternate directions using side streets that are not one way if needed.
- Our office is located in the large “tan” building with the Solar Turbines name at the top. The building is easily seen from the Northwest Freeway, but is actually located behind another (shorter) office building. A driveway located off of the Northwest Freeway provides access to both our building and the adjacent parking garage (see next note).
- Parking is available around the building or in the adjacent garage at no charge. Most parking spots in the garage are reserved for tenants, but there is a visitor’s section available on the bottom level.
